

**2022 Agua Dulce Country Fair & Parade
PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS**

All applicants must sign this release. Please return all signed releases with Parade application

1. **Please be on time.** Line up begins at 2:00 pm (*see below for instructions*) with road closures at 3:30 pm (meaning no Vehicles and/or Equestrians in or out). The **parade begins at 4:00 pm sharp** at the intersection of Davenport Road & Agua Dulce Canyon Road, and ends at the intersection of Darling Road & Agua Dulce Canyon Road.
2. **Checking in:**
 - a. **Equestrian Entries:** Check-in begins at 2:00 pm at the iLead school campus (the old Agua Dulce Elementary School, lower parking lot) located at the intersection of Agua Dulce Cyn Road and 11311 Frascati Road. Here, you will unload and stage your entries. After unloading, you have two options: remained parked at the school parking lot, or park on Darling Road, where the parade ends. For safety reasons, you will not be allowed back down Agua Dulce Canyon Road at the end of the parade. Ask for directions at the Equestrian Check-in Table, which will be at the gate where you will enter the school parking lot.
 - b. **Floats/Vehicles (non-equestrian):** Check-in begins at 2:00 pm at the Agua Dulce Movie Ranch Hacienda Vasquez, located at 32590 Agua Dulce Canyon Road (directly across from Davenport Road). The check-in table will be at the front gate, where you will receive your number and place in the lineup. Here you will have time to add final decorations and prepare until we leave the gate at 4:00 pm sharp.
3. **Judging: Select all applicable categories for your entry.** The more you qualify for, the greater your chance of winning a prize! All equestrian prizes will be awarded prior to the parade start so winners can display their ribbons during the parade route. All other categories will be judged at the end of the parade route, prizes will be awarded at the Fair. **Note: For "Best Overall" & "Best Use of Theme" all entries in categories A - W will be judged for both categories.**
4. **It will be warm.** Please provide water and other necessary safety items for people and animals.
5. **All animals must be under control.** All dogs must be on a leash, and if you have other animals (such as horses or livestock), you must practice safe handling of them and maintain control of your animal at all times.
6. **For the safety of all participants and spectators, water guns are not allowed.**
7. **Consumption of alcohol and drugs are strictly prohibited to Parade participants. Violators will be disqualified and removed from judging and line. California Vehicle Codes: Section 21050. Every person riding or driving an animal upon a highway has all of the rights and is subject to all of the duties applicable to the driver of a vehicle by this division and Division 10 (commencing with Section 20000), except those provisions which by their very nature can have no application. Section 23152. (A) It is unlawful for a person who is under the influence of any alcoholic beverage to drive a vehicle. (B) It is unlawful for a person who has 0.08 percent or more, by weight, of alcohol in his or her blood to drive a vehicle.**
8. **Once the Parade is over, all State, County and City statutes of the code will be enforced by Law Authorities.**
9. **HAVE FUN!** Just after the Parade ends, don't forget to join us for the Country Fair! The new location for the Fair is located at the ADWC at Agua Dulce Canyon Road, runs from 5:00 pm until 11:00pm.
